Transitional Housing

We have provided safe, affordable and nurturing transitional housing at our Hope Houses for the past three decades. We operate five, six-bed homes (2 for women* and 3 for men) located in residential settings throughout Redwood City. Our homes are substance free and provide residents an opportunity to get back on their feet while they work towards their goals. Additionally, we offer programs which assist with rent, case management services and peer support.

Many of our clients are justice involved and are referred from Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment programs and community partners. We accept all gender identities and do not discriminate by race, religion, sex, gender, ethnicity, age, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression.



Resident Qualifications:

- Successful completion of a SUD Treatment program.
- Willing to remain clean and sober.
- Working, enrolled in an Intensive Outpatient or Outpatient Program, or enrolled in school while living in our homes.
- Attendance at weekly House Meetings and 12 step-meetings.
- Motivated to make positive changes in their life.
- Willing to follow the guidelines of the transitional program.
- 18 years or older.
- Low income.

**Priority is given to graduates of our Women's Hope House Residential Treatment Program.*
